*All students will be required to take an English Placement examination. Some students, based on their score will be required to take ENGL 107 Developmental English.

**All students will be required to take a Mathematics Placement examination. Some students, based on their score will be required to take Beginning Algebra, MATH 104 or Intermediate Algebra, MATH 106. These courses do not count for General Education credit.
